### **Tennessee Laws Protecting Breastfeeding**

A mother may breastfeed in any public or private place she is authorized to be. (TCA 68-58-101)

Breastfeeding shall not be considered public indecency or nudity, obscene, or sexual conduct. (TCA 68-58-102)

Local governments shall not prohibit breastfeeding in public by local ordinance. (TCA -68-58-103)

Employers must accommodate breastfeeding mothers at work. (TCA 50-1-305)

IBCLC: International Board Certified Lactation Consultant: A professional who specializes in the clinical management of breastfeeding which includes: preventive healthcare, patient education, nutrition counseling, and therapeutic treatment. An IBCLC is certified by the International Board of Lactation Consultant Examiners and works in a variety of settings, providing leadership, advocacy, professional development, and research in the lactation field.

**CLC:** Certified Lactation Counselor: A professional in lactation counseling who has demonstrated the necessary skills, knowledge, and attitudes to provide clinical breastfeeding counseling and management support to families who are thinking about breastfeeding or who have questions or problems during the course of breastfeeding/lactation.
